167 – Process for Board Member Policy Violations

The Board and its members are committed to faithful compliance with the provisions of the Board's policies. In the event of a member's willful and/or continuing violation of policy, any Board member(s) may seek remedy by the following process:

- a. Notification of the violation presented to the president of the board.
- b. Conversation in a private setting between the offending member and the Board president or other individual member.
- c. Discussion in a public session between the offending member and the full Board.
- d. Public censure of the offending member of the Board.
